It will house Women and Children Acute Hospital, and will provide surgery, obstetrics and imaging services to support Med/Surg, Peds, PICU, ICU, CCU and Psychiatric beds.

Budget: \$800 million Construction Cost

The hospital HVAC system uses 100% outside air with heat recovery to prevent MDRTB transmission and to maintain good air quality, variable air volume systems will supply patient rooms. The air-handling units are located above the podium and above the towers.

Completion: 2012

The Central Plant houses chillers, boilers, cooling towers and emergency generators and is located at the top floors of the South Tower.
