This medical center was planned to be the flagship hospital for the 14 Kaiser Medical Centers in Northern California. The hospital accommodates 318 patient beds, including 33 NICU, 32 ICU and 33 ICU beds, surgeries "A" and "B" consisting of 12 operating rooms, radiology and materials management departments. The Central Utility Plant contains equipment to provide chilled and hot water, steam, medical and laboratory air, medical and laboratory vacuum to the hospital and the Medical Office Buildings.
