The Los Angeles Medical Center (LAMC) is one of Kaiser Permanente's largest inpatient hospitals in California. This replacement hospital will provide comprehensive acute inpatient care, including the most advanced tertiary care, cardiovascular surgery, pediatric intensive care, neurosurgery, spine surgery and high obstetrics.

The hospital HVAC system uses 100% outside air with heat recovery to prevent MDRTB transmission and to maintain good indoor air quality. The Central Plant houses centrifugal and gas engine-driven chillers, boilers and emergency generators.
